This includes, but is not limited to, Time and Voyage Charterparties, Contracts of Affreightment and FFA agreements that are not given up for clearing. Both counterparties are required to have a valid Baltic Data licence.

Baltic Data is based on assessments made by Panellist Brokers. One of the ways to obtain a Baltic Data licence is to nominate a Baltic Panellist Broker in the contract.
